## NICOLA DALY

In this talk, Prof. Nicola Daly will traverse a range of research studies exploring the contribution of dual-language picturebooks to language revitalisation in Aotearoa New Zealand. Drawing on her new book, *Language, Identity and Diversity in Picturebooks: An Aotearoa New Zealand Perspective,* she will present findings showing how dual-language picturebooks in Aotearoa can both reflect and disrupt language hierarchies.



Nicola Daly is a sociolinguist and Associate Professor in the Division of Education, University of Waikato, where she teaches children's literature and leads the Postgraduate Certificate in Children's and Young Adult Literature.
